HEREBY DECIDES AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: A competitive entrance examination is hereby launched for admission of 430 students into the first year for the award of Bachelor of Engineering (B.Eng) and subsequently the Professional Master of Engineering (M.Eng) of the National Higher Polytechnic Institute (NAHPI) of The University of Bamenda for the 2024/2025 academic year in the following programmes:

<u>Article 2</u>: The competitive entrance examination is opened to Cameroonians and foreigners (foreigners pay higher fees unless regulated otherwise; please visit <u>www.nahpi.cm</u> to learn more) of both sexes. Prospective applicants must have the following general requirements:

- a) General Certificate of Education (GCE) Ordinary Level with passes in science subjects, including Mathematics and English Language or an English Language Proficiency Test; and GCE Advanced Level with passes in at least two science subjects, except for Computer Engineering and Meteorology Engineering where GCE A4 series students with an A or B-grade in A/L Mathematics and a pass in O/L Physics would be sufficient to sit for the Entrance Exam. A Pass in Mathematics at GCE Advanced Level is required for candidates without a pass in Mathematics at the GCE Ordinary Level.
- b) Technical GCE Ordinary Level with a pass in Mathematics and English Language or an English Language Proficiency Test, and Technical GCE Advanced Level with a pass in at least two relevant technical subjects. A Pass in Mathematics at Technical GCE Advanced Level is required for candidates without a pass in Mathematics at Technical GCE Ordinary Lever.
- c) Probatoire C, D, E, F1, F2, F3, F4, MISE and TIC; with a pass in Mathematics and English Language or an English Language Proficiency Test, and subsequently a Baccalaureate with passes in at least two relevant science subjects. A Pass in Mathematics at Baccalaureate is required for candidates without a pass in Mathematics at Probatoire.
- d) Any other certificates recognized as equivalent by the Ministry of Higher Education.

Article 3: The application procedure and deadline are as follows:

a. Payment of twenty thousand (20,000) FCFA as non-refundable entrance registration fees into the account of NAHPI at UBA Bank using the following bank code 10033, branch code 05204, and account number 040040009038. NB: No other form of payment is acceptable; the payment of this fee is a pre-requisite for the online registration in step b below.

- b. Filling and submission of a registration form by the candidate, **online**, **at the NAHPI website** <u>www.nahpi.cm</u> after payment of the entrance examination fee. Print a copy of the submission confirmation page or acceptance slip, keep safely for submission to the chief invigilator on the day of the written exam;
- c. The deadline for the online registration is Friday 16th August 2024
- d. Carry a complete application file to the written examination centre and submit to the Chief Invigilator from NAHPI on the day of the written exam. This complete application file must contain the following:
- The original receipt from UBA Bank (see Article 3a above)
- The online submission confirmation page or Acceptance Slip (see Article 3b above).
- A certified true copy of birth certificate dated not more than three (03) months;
- A medical certificate of fitness issued by a State Medical Practitioner dated not more than three (03) months;
- A certified true copy of GCE O/L or Probatoire or equivalent diploma dated not more than three (03) months;
- A certified true copy of GCE A/L or Baccalaureate or equivalent diploma or results slip for High School graduates of the same year, dated not more than three (03) months;
- Certified true copies of Transcripts of GCE O/L or Probatoire and GCE A/L or Baccalaureate.
- Four passport-sized photographs;
- One self-addressed large envelop bearing a 400 francs CFA postal stamp;

Article 4: Candidates <u>awaiting the results</u> of certificate examinations mentioned in Article 2 above should wait for the release of such results because they will need them to complete the online form.

NB: on the online form, the entry of any false results or grades will automatically lead to disqualification of the candidate.

Article 5: On the day of the written examination, candidates are requested to come along with their National Identity Cards or School Identity Cards or other official photo identification papers, which must be presented to the examination authorities to gain access into the hall.

Article 6: The examination will be written on the 24th of August 2024 starting at 8.00 am, in the following Centres only: Bafoussam, Bambili, Buea, Douala and Yaoundé. Details on writing centres will be published few days to the examination date over the CRTV network and/or on the NAHPI website at www.nahpi.cm.

Article 7: The competitive entrance examination and syllabus shall be organized as follows:

Article 8: The assessment of the competive entrance examination shall be as follows:

Paper 1: 30/100; Paper 2: 30/100; Paper 3: 10/100; Study of files: 30/100. The study of files will take into consideration the grades or averages obtained at GCE O/L and GCE A/L or Probatoire and Baccalauréat; Age of the candidate; and the specialty subjects passed.

Article 9: There will be no oral examination.

Article 10: A jury designated by the competent authority shall prepare the list of successful candidates per programme by order of merit and submit it, in strict compliance, to the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education for publication.

Article 11: Successful candidates, who obtain a Bachelor of Engineering of the National Higher Polytechnic Institute of The University of Bamenda after four (04) years of successful studies qualify for enrolment into a one (01) year Professional Master of Engineering (M.Eng.) programme if they proceed immediately.

Article 12: The Vice Chancellor of The University of Bamenda, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality and the Director of the National Higher Polytechnic Institute are each in his/her own sphere, responsible for the implementation of this decision which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever necessary.
