The Vice-Chancellor of The University of Bamenda announces to candidates for the written part of the Competitive Entrance Examination into the First Year of studies at the National Higher Polytechnic Institute (NAHPI) that the said examination will effectively take place on Sunday, September 20th, 2026 as initially scheduled, in the following five centres, starting at 8.00 am prompt:

- Bafoussam, at Lycée Bilingue de Bafoussam
- Bambili, at The University of Bamenda main campus as follows: Civil Engineering – Amphi 650; Computer Engineering – Amphi 340 and nearby halls; the rest in PBA and PBB halls
- Buea, at The University of Buea main campus
- Douala, at the University Institute of Technology (IUT) campus, University of Douala
- Yaoundé, at the National Advanced School of Engineering (Polytechnic) campus, University of Yaounde I

More directives on halls will be placed at the entrance to the various campuses and candidates should come along with the following usable materials only: a **2B pencil**, a **sharpener**, a **non-programmable calculator**, as well the other requirements listed in the call for applications.

Prospective candidates should continue to register for the examination online, until end of Friday September 18th, 2026. Those for the **Bambili and Buea Centres** who may be unable to complete the registration process by this new deadline should still come for the examination with the originals of their documents and all the other requirements. However, they must complete the registration online and offline no later than Thursday September 24th, 2026.
